SINCE I LAST WROTE AN ANNUAL REPORT, WE HAVE SEEN A YEAR OF HIGHS AND LOWS, BOTH AT KURN HATTIN HOMES AND IN THE WORLD. THE IMPACT OF THOSE **EVENTS HAS TRANSFORMED THE HOMES IN SUBSTANTIVE** WAYS, SIGNIFICANTLY FOR THE BETTER IN MOST CASES, **ALTHOUGH WE STILL FACE CHALLENGES.**

Financially, Kurn Hattin Homes has enjoyed the support of a myriad of donors for years, and for that support we are extremely grateful. Direct donations account for about 40% of our operational expenses annually, and we are working hard to increase this portion of our income in order to decrease our reliance on the Homes' endowment funds. We only receive around 5% of our income from various types of government support. The largest share of our operational budget, about 55%, comes from funds derived from the Homes' endowment fund, which itself consists of money that came from individual charitable contributions. Without the endowment's income and support, the Homes would not be able to provide the program for children that we do, but our annual draw from endowment income and funds is larger than is sustainable over the next 75 years. Still, we are grateful that the market (at the time of this writing) seems to be holding relatively firm.

The educational program began well last year with a census of about 72 children. Last October we hosted the New England Association of Schools and Colleges' Accreditation Visiting Team, which was here to evaluate Kurn Hattin Homes for NEASC accreditation. We received a favorable review and responded promptly to a few of their suggestions for improvements. These improvements included upgraded training and working conditions for residential staff, more health and mental health coverage in the afternoons and evenings, and enhanced safety measures (including cameras, etc.) on campus. All of their recommendations have been acted on since their report to us last January, and we expect full accreditation from NEASC (in addition to our on-going certification from the state AOE) to be forthcoming any time now. With the impending accreditation of our school and residential program by NEASC, we requested and were granted release from being a Residential Treatment Program by the Department of Children and Families (DCF). This is a recognition that while our children come from difficult

home situations, they are not here for "treatment" programs. All of these developments are moving us in a positive direction.

Last March. Kurn Hattin Homes was impacted by the coronavirus pandemic. We made the extremely difficult decision to follow the state guidelines to close our campus and send our children back to their own homes. We continued to pay salaries and benefits to all employees during the closure. Our staff stepped up to the challenges of a closed campus marvelously. The teachers maintained outstanding contact with children through mail and electronic media to keep learning going. Residential staff completed innumerable cleaning and renovation projects in the cottages/buildings, as well as on outside trails. Our maintenance and farm staff continued their wonderful upkeep of the campus and found even more projects to complete during the closure. Still, not having children on campus was a sad state of affairs at Kurn Hattin Homes! It was a happy day indeed when, in mid-July, the summer camp program reopened the campus to our children once again! Life was different as we observed stringent COVID-19 safety protocols, but the joy of having our children back over-shadowed any inconvenience, and the same was true of our August start of the academic year!

In July we were devastated and horrified by the revelations about two groups of alumni from the 1960s and '80s who came forward with stories of alleged abuse. We are unsure how long investigations will take, but we must make this situation as "right" as we can for all of our children, past and present. It is crucial that we: 1. Acknowledge the pain and suffering of these alumni and help them feel the love and acceptance that the vast majority of our children feel, and 2. Ensure that nothing of this sort can or will occur again so that the Homes can meet the needs of children faithfully for another 125 years! We are confident that both of these goals are being met thoroughly, but healing takes time, and protection of children is always a vigilant and conscious task.

These have been, and continue to be, times that try folks' souls. Yet we know that our work has meaning and makes a difference in this world! Our mission is to transform the lives of children for the better! That is what we have done, are continuing to do today, and will keep doing in the future. Please join us in this renewed commitment to help transform lives!

ANNUAL REPORT from the FINANCIAL MANAGER

Kurn Hattin's finances were very much a major concern this past year with the onset of the Pandemic in early spring. We strategically decided not to lay off any employees even though we were without students for approximately four and half months and saw a significant drop in revenue. Our dedicated staff, without question, is our most valuable asset. Fortunately, we were able to secure a loan through the Payroll Protection Program funded by the Federal government that allowed us to substantially cover salaries and benefits during the latter part of the fiscal year. We expect this loan to be forgiven under the forgiveness terms of the loan program.

The other major pandemic impact was the dramatic hit to the market value of our endowment in March when it lost approximately \$5 million in value. The market has rallied since March regaining much of this loss. As of June 30, 2020 the endowment value is \$42.8 million. Special thanks to Kurn Hattin's Investment Committee. This volunteer committee works hard to make sure that Kurn Hattin's endowment is in the best position to achieve growth and to support Kurn Hattin's operations. Building the endowment through positive investment performance and new gifts is an ongoing priority.

THE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FROM DONORS CONTINUES TO **MAKE IT POSSIBLE TO POSITIVELY IMPACT THE LIVES OF** CHILDREN AND THEIR FAMILIES.

Gifts to the endowment, annual contributions, estate gifts, and outside trusts established by donors to provide annual income has made it possible to sustain Kurn Hattin. As noted in the financial report on the next page, approximately 95% of Kurn Hattin's income is from philanthropic sources.

Total operating expense in Fiscal 2020 of \$5.5 million was \$140,000 or 2.5% below budget. Capital expenditures totaled \$284,000. This included energy conservation projects in the Mayo Memorial Center, repairs to the sugar house, replacement of the dump truck, septic repairs, engineering costs for a new water filtration system (to be completed in Fiscal 2021), new crosswalk lighting signs, new furnace in Tackaberry Cottage, new water heaters in several cottages, and other building improvements.


